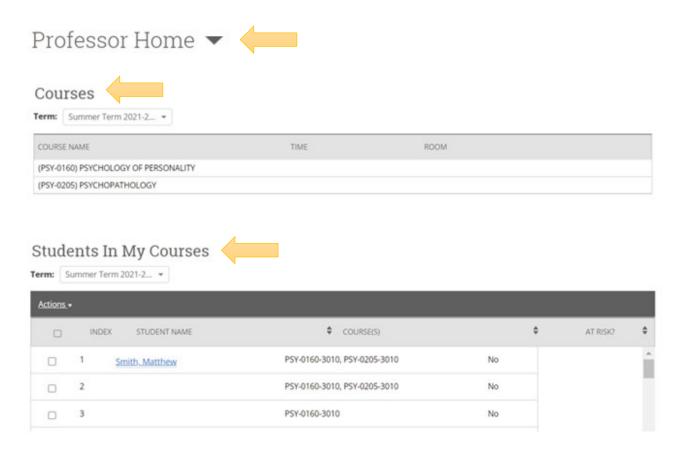
## How Instructors Can Make a Referral for a Student

- 1. Log in to Pathways using your Pitt credentials.
- 2. **If necessary, toggle from your "Staff Home" to your "Professor Home" page.** This page displays the courses you are teaching in the current term and the students enrolled in those courses. You can toggle from your Staff Home (which is used for setting availability for Faculty Advisors or Faculty Office Hours to your Professor Home by clicking the gray triangle.



3. Click the hyperlink for the student's name for whom you would like to make a referral.

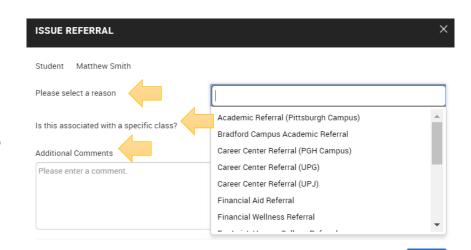
4. This brings you to the student's home. On the righthand side, click on the hyperlink to "Issue a Referral".
